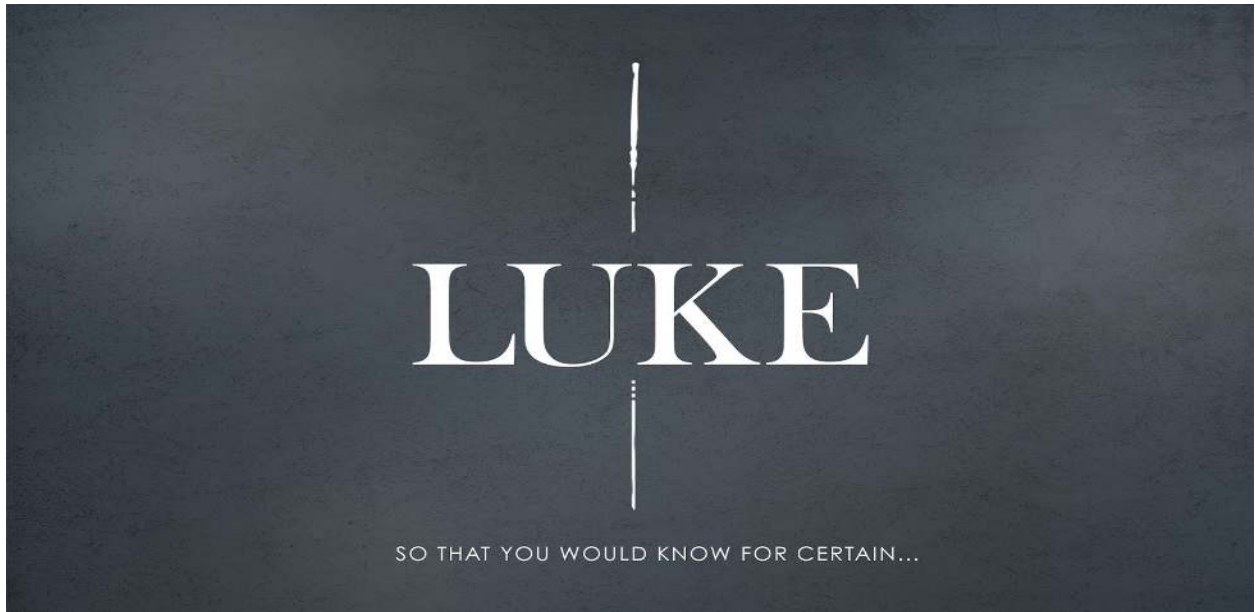


Application Questions

Luke 3:1-20



Introduction

John the Baptist begins to prepare the way for Jesus by inviting those waiting for the (mostly political) Savior to come. He says that the Kingdom of God is coming, and it's possible to miss Him all together if we're not careful. John says that we should be ready with repentance to experience forgiveness.

Questions:

1. Why do you think many people avoid and refuse this incredible offer to experience the forgiveness of sin?
 2. What was the time that you were overwhelmed with your sin and knew you needed to find forgiveness?

3. What do you think is more difficult situation for a person to seek forgiveness- The person who has been “good” most of their life or the person who’s past is loaded with baggage and mistakes?
 4. True repentance requires humility and obedience. Which of those do you think is more difficult? How are they similar?

James 4:8-10, Proverbs 28:13

5. Forgiveness requires genuine repentance. Many of the religious rulers placed their faith in heritage rather than obedience. What do you think most people place their faith in for forgiveness?

6. Repentance Brings New Life- What part of life do you continually need Christ to renew for you and in you?

7. Take some time to rehearse and remember the gospel with your group.
