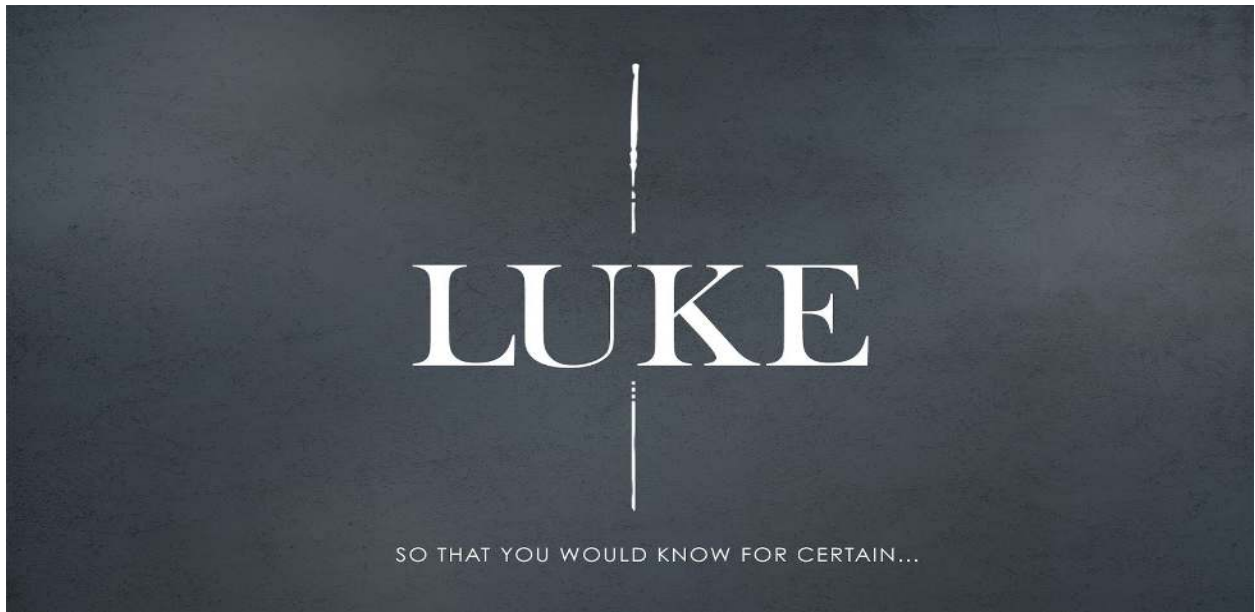

# Temptation: The Bait & The Stakes

## Luke 4:1-13

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### Introduction

Not long after Jesus rises out of the waters of baptism, he is led into the wilderness and tempted by Satan. Through this incredibly vulnerable moment, we learn the traps of the enemy and how to fight temptation like Jesus.

### Luke 4:1-13

Questions:

1. Scripture is clear (John 10:10, 1 Peter 5:8) that Satan has a plan to destroy our life. How often do you think about the fact that the enemy has placed traps around your life?

2. When do you feel the most vulnerable to temptation?
  3. What makes you feel isolated more than anything else?

4. Satan attempts to make us doubt the provision and the plan of God. How does this look in life's circumstances for you right now?

5. Why do you think it's so difficult to be vulnerable to each other in a spiritual community?

6. What do you think of this quote from Sunday "We can be vulnerable to each other, or to the enemy- it's your choice."

7. Out of the three ways (resist, run, recruit) that Brian listed to fight temptation, which is the most difficult for you?

8. In which ways do you need community to help you at this moment in your life?

9. What is the greatest area of temptation for you right now? How can your small group come around you to help?
