



SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

TAKE A QUICK READ THROUGH EXODUS 24

1. God invites / commands Moses and the elders (and subsequently Israel) to come to the mountain and worship. Before songs were written about him, and before they had any Scripture from him, what do you think worship looked like?
2. Many times, our “ability” to worship depends on our mood, circumstance, song selection, or how gifted the speaker is. What does that reveal about us and our perception of God?
3. Even though God commands Israel to worship, it’s only Moses that can come close. Scripture tells us that Christ has brought us who were far off, near. Why then do we sometimes feel far from God?
4. What are ways that we can grow in our understanding of God, our great mediator Jesus, and our obedience in worship?
