



Read John 1:1-18

1. John begins to introduce Jesus by context of the Old Testament and with understanding of an all powerful God. If you were to describe and introduce Jesus to someone who has never heard of him, what attributes about him and his identity would you use and why?
2. John is also making the case that Jesus is clearly God himself; a claim Jesus would accept (Jn. 17:5). If this is true, that God left heaven to come and die for us, then God loves you more than you can imagine. How is this different than we are sometimes tempted to think about God or what our culture thinks about God?
3. What does the fact that God would come and take on the penalty for our sins *against Him* say about Him?
4. Secondly, if Jesus is God- then it is paramount how we respond to him. What are some of the things that Jesus says that our world finds difficult? What are some of the things that Jesus says or promises that you find difficult?
