



## Read John 6:15-58

1. After struggling most of the night, John makes it clear that the disciples were “willing to take Him into the boat”. Why do you think that was even a question?
  1. How long does it typically take you to invite Jesus into your struggle?
  2. What are the factors that keep you from doing that sooner?
2. The people weren’t entirely wrong for seeking Jesus because they were mesmerized by his power. The problem is- they confused what they believed he could do for them with what he came to do for them. How do we continually remind ourselves that Jesus is dedicated to our eternity?
3. We can often work for “food that perishes”, Jesus says. To say it another way- we consume our lives with things that will eventually be outdated, rundown, or forgotten.
4. How do we carry a balance of enjoying the good things of this life while keeping our singular focus on eternity?
5. What are the actual things you are tempted to pursue and set your gaze on?
6. How can we allow Jesus to change and shape our cravings?
