Discussion Questions:

1. How do you typically respond when you encounter suffering or difficulties in life? What emotions or thoughts come up for you?
2. Have you ever seen God work through a challenging situation in a surprising way? Share an example if you feel comfortable.
3. Suffering is not always a direct result of personal sin. Jesus explained the man was born blind so that God's works might be displayed in him. How does that make you feel?
4. When we give our suffering over to Jesus, He can redeem it for His glory and our good. He doesn't waste a drop of what we go through. When have you seen Jesus do this in your story?
5. We may not always understand why God allows certain things, but we can choose to trust His character and purposes, even when it's difficult. His ways are higher than ours.
6. What stood out to you most from this sermon? Did any points challenge or encourage you?
