Discussion Questions:

1. The sermon discusses Jesus' decision to stay when He heard Lazarus was sick. Have you ever felt like God was delaying in answering your prayers? How did you respond?
2. What does Jesus' weeping tell us about His character and His relationship with us?
3. How does the story of Lazarus' resurrection challenge or strengthen your faith in Jesus' power over death?
4. The pastor mentioned that "Jesus breaks into funerals and makes them weddings." How have you seen Jesus bring hope or joy into seemingly hopeless situations?
5. Reflect on the phrase "Jesus stares into the darkness of death and commands light and life to burst forth." How does this impact your view of Jesus and His power?
6. The sermon talks about being "spiritually dead" and Jesus calling us to life. How would you explain this concept to someone who is not familiar with Christianity?
