

Read John 14:1-15 Discussion Questions:

How does Jesus' description of heaven as a real place with 'many rooms' challenge or affirm your current understanding of the afterlife?

In what ways might our longing for 'heaven on earth' distract us from fully embracing Jesus' promise of eternal life with Him?

How does Jesus' statement 'I am the way, the truth, and the life' impact your view of other religions and paths to God?

What are some practical ways we can align our prayers with Jesus' instruction to ask 'in His name' for the glory of the Father?

How might understanding Jesus' intimate relationship with the Father change the way we approach our own relationship with God?

In what ways can we as believers participate in the 'greater works' Jesus speaks of, beyond just miraculous signs?

How does viewing unanswered prayers through the lens of Christ's sacrifice on the cross change our perspective on God's love and plans for us?

What are some challenges we face in fully embracing Jesus' exclusivity as the only way to the Father in our pluralistic society?

How can we cultivate a deeper longing for the presence of God in heaven, rather than focusing solely on the material aspects often associated with it?

In what ways might our understanding of Jesus' deity impact our daily walk with Him and our approach to prayer?
